The Metro Atlanta Police and Fire Foundation will be hosting a charity ice hockey game and family skate to help raise money for Firefighter Damon Gensel.

Gensel, 42, was diagnosed with acute lymphocytic leukemia (ALL), a type of blood cancer last November and is urgently in need of a bone marrow transplant.

The 16 1/2-year veteran of Cobb County Fire & Emergency Services was informed he has Philadelphia's Chromosome and a unique strand on his DNA, his chances for a bone marrow match is zero to 1 percent. The Philadelphia Chromosome is a mutating chromosome condition, causes higher relapse and higher mortality rate.

Damon is married and is the father of two teenagers, aged 16 and 12.
