Hunter is only 23 and is battling Burkitt's Lymphoma. This is a sever cancer. He has received a great deal of treatment at Emory Hospital in Atlanta. Emory has exhausted their resources and Hunter needs treatment at M.D. Anderson Hospital's Cancer Facility in Houston, TX. This is going to be an extremely expensive trip. This is Hunter's best chance for survival.
